


- **1.** Gather supplies and Seizure Action Plan and Medical Alert Information (SAP) form.
- 2. Check the expiry date on the lorazepam (Ativan). If it has expired, do not give. Call parents and 911.
- 3. Check the 5 Rights of Medication Administration (refer to the SAP): Right medication (lorazepam/Ativan), Right student (see SAP), Right time (see SAP), Right dose (single dose in pharmacy labelled container/package as provided by parent/guardian), Right route (buccal).
- 4. Clean hands and place glove on one hand.
- 5. With gloved hand, place lorazepam (Ativan) tablet(s) in student's cheek between the cheek and the gums (buccal pocket) near their back teeth.



6. Gently **hold** the tablet there for 20-30 seconds, giving it time to dissolve.
