

SPROUT Admission Criteria

Residency	BC and Yukon residents with active MSP coverage. <i>*During the pilot phase, only referrals from BCCH clinics will be accepted.*</i>
Medical Stability & Support Requirements	Medically stable enough to participate as outpatients and able to tolerate at least one 45-minute therapy session. Parents or caregivers must be able to transport and accompany the patient during sessions, or patients must be capable of independent travel within the community. <i>*During the pilot phase, we will rely on social workers from referring clinics for support in exploring subsidized accommodation options.*</i>
Therapy Requirements & Accessibility	Require a minimum of two types of therapies, which may include occupational therapy, physiotherapy, speech language pathology, recreational/aquatic therapy; <i>OR</i> require specialized therapy services exclusive to SHHC (Tier 6). No access to alternative rehab service that provides the appropriate intensity and type of care required by the patient (specific therapy goals that cannot be met by less intensive services).
Pt Conditions for Eligibility	ARU inpatients/day-patients eligible for discharge and continue rehabilitation as outpatients. Require rehabilitation after orthopedic or neurosurgical procedures. Require pre-surgical or pre-oncological treatments to enhance surgical outcomes & recovery. Require intensified therapy for patients with chronic diseases or post-acute events, such as deconditioning or long-term immobility.

Please note that meeting admission criteria does not guarantee admission due to various factors. All referrals will be reviewed during SPROUT intake meetings, and referring clinics will receive a response promptly.
