STEP 1 - SET UP

Clean the area where your supplies will be placed with alcohol or a disinfectant wipe and gather your supplies.

- (2) Saline Flush
- (1) Heparin Flush
- (3) Chlorhexidine Swab
- (1) Medicine (Elastomeric Pump)
- (1) Disinfectant Cap



STEP 3 – SALINE FLUSH


- 1. Prepare saline syringe.
- 2. Clean needleless connector.
- 3. Attach saline syringe.
- 4. Unclamp and flush with 9 mL saline (Push-pause method)
- 5. Re-clamp

STEP 4 – ATTACH MEDICINE

- 1. Clean needleless connector.
- 2. Attach medicine.
- 3. Unclamp to start.
- 4. When finished re-clamp.

1.Wash your hands. 2.Prepare saline and heparin syringes.

3.Detach empty bag or syringe. 4.Clean needleless connector. 5.Attach saline syringe. 6. Unclamp and flush with 9 mL saline. (Push-pause method) 7. Re-clamp.

SCRUB TIMES: Swab: 30 second scrub to blue cap and 1 minute dry







STEP 2 – CLEAN HANDS

Wash your hands for one full minute. Dry with paper towel.






STEP 5 – SALINE FLUSH

STEP 6– HEPARIN FLUSH

1.Clean needleless connector. 2.Attach heparin syringe. 3.Unclamp and flush with 1.5 mL heparin. (Push-pause method) 4. Re-clamp. 5.Apply disinfectant cap.



Note: When medicines are no longer being given through the line(s) saline will no longer be needed. Heparin flush only in each line every 24 hours.
