What is subsidized housing in BC?

Subsidized housing is **long-term housing for people who permanently reside in British Columbia**. Rental fees are calculated on a rent geared to income basis (30% of household total gross income, subject to minimum rent based on # of people).

How do I apply for low income housing in BC?

BC Housing manages public housing in B.C., and maintains the housing registry, a subsidized housing listing and application service. The housing registry includes public housing and some non-profit and co-op housing. Call toll-free: 1-800-257-7756 (604-433-2218 in the Lower Mainland).

Who is eligible for rent subsidy in BC?

The Rental Assistance Program provides eligible **low-income working families** with monthly assistance to help with their monthly rent payments. To qualify, families must have a total before-tax household income of \$40,000 or less, were working at some point in the last year, and have at least one dependent child.
